Additional drivers will must submit their own entry form and use their member number to generate their entry number.

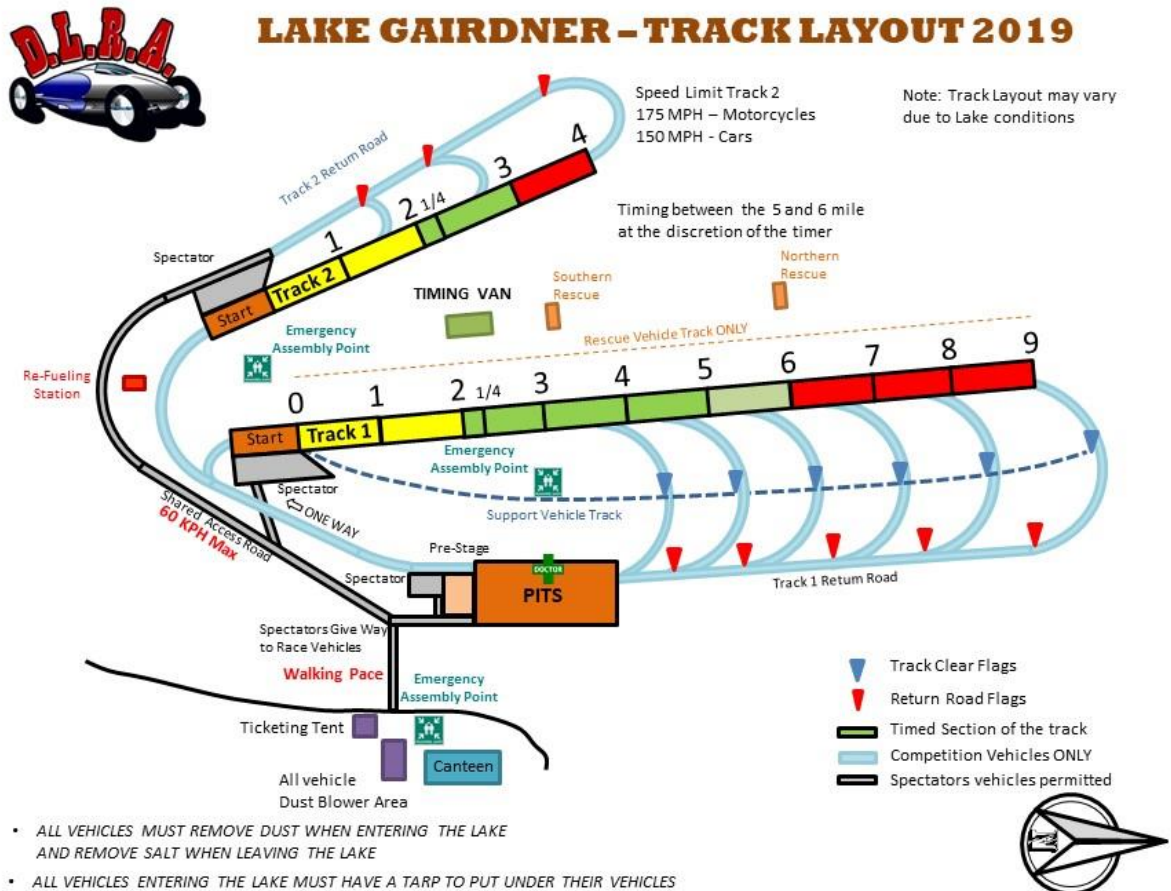

Hazardous Chemical Register

A Hazardous chemical register is a list of all hazardous chemicals used, handled or stored within your pit. You must attach the current safety data sheet (SDS) with this register as part of your entry to DLRA Speed Week. The Safety Data Sheet will tell you how to use and manage hazardous chemicals safely. The supplier of your chemicals should provide a Safety Data Sheet upon request. **Note:** Chemicals not classified as hazardous chemicals do not require SDSs and do not need be included in this register.

How can you tell if a chemical is classed as hazardous?

Section 2 of the SDS will tell you if, and how the chemical is hazardous. Other indications are:

- The manufacturer or supplier provided a copy of the SDS with the chemical
- The label of the product includes:
 - diamond-shaped warning pictograms (see right)
 - signal words *Danger* or *Warning*
 - hazard or precautionary statements such as *Toxic if swallowed* and *Wear eye protection*
 - risk or safety phrases such as *Harmful if swallowed* and *Keep out of the reach of children*.

Contact the manufacturer or supplier for more details or for a copy of the SDS. Many companies also provide SDSs online.
