LAKE CONDITION AND INSPECTION

A final lake inspection will take place on 9th March 2023, as soon as I hear news from the team I will be posting it to the website, Facebook and the Forum.

A report over Christmas was that the salt was still a bit damp and you were picking up a bit of salt as you travelled over it. This is nothing new, and I can remember previous years when it was like this and it just got better as the week went on.

The long term forecasts are looking okay with little to no rain in February and modeling showing some rain in March with the finish of La Niña at the end of February. The average for January was 36° with a top of 43° and only 23mm of rain that all fell on one day. So far this month we have an average of 32.6° with a top of 40.5° The expected top temps for Speed Week range from 34° to 28°.

VOLUNTEERS

We cannot run an event without our volunteers! It is as simple as that, if you're an entrant and have already nominated for your mandatory one shift, why not have a think about doing a second shift. There are many shifts that are now shorter hours than the usual half days that we have had in the past. So it will be over and done with before you know it!

You don't have to be an entrant or even a member for that matter to be a volunteer, you just need to want to help the club have a successful event and everyone have a good time.

We are always looking for experienced ex-entrants to help fill some of those more technical roles, so even if you are not racing, there is plenty of opportunities to be involved.

SPEED WEEK 2023

We continue to encourage entrants to get their entries in as soon as they can.

The final day for pre-entries is the 6th March 2023, and after that time late entries will attract a \$250.00 late entry fee, so GET YOUR ENTRY IN NOW!

Those people that are rolling over their entry from 2022 will need to complete a 2023 entry form and indicate that it is a roll over. Note, you will still have to pay your annual subscription. 2022 entrants should have received an email from Gemma Dunn about rolling over their volunteering by now along with getting a new code to put on their entry form, if you have not seen these emails please contact Gemma now at volunteers@dlra.org.au

Thanks to all those people who have now paid their annual subscription, this greatly helps the club and gives us increased confidence to commit our time and energy to making the DLRA the great club it is.

A useful reminder for anyone coming to Speed Week 2023 to bring their own leaf blower to get all the dust off their vehicle before entering the lake. This will make entering the lake quicker and easier for all.

TROPHIES AND AWARDS

As usual, there will be a number of trophies up for grabs at Speedweek, These include; Rangers Choice, GRAC Monitors Choice, Tidiest Pit Area, Rookie of the Year, Fastest Lady of the Lake, Fastest Ute or Pickup, Best presented Car, Best Presented Motorcycle, Best Presented Crew, Race Directors pick, Presidents Choice, and Top Time of the Meet.

This year we have introduced a new "Perpetual Trophy", that carries a great honour with it.

It is "The Greg Telford Memorial

Trophy". This is for the most valuable volunteer of the year. If you get to have your name on this, you will be forever a piece of DLRA history, and help maintain the memory of one of our own. There will also be a memento for each recipient to keep, but more about that soon.

GOLDEN TICKET

The idea behind the concept is to generate some additional funding where an event is cancelled.



The final rules are that any previous entrant from a cancelled event with fees held by the club now has the option to forfeit their entry fee in return for a golden ticket which entitles them to enter a daily draw. The draw will take place on the Sunday afternoon prior to Speed Week and five names will be drawn out, one for each consecutive day of racing. The lucky winners will be entitled to be the first vehicle off the start line on that day. A Golden Ticket can be transferrable to another entrant, officials must be notified prior to the ticket being presented.

CAR TECHNICAL INSPECTION

This is to help you better understand what is required in building and presenting your vehicle.

Speedweek 2023 Car tech inspection times will be as follows;

FRIDAY: 12:00-Noon – 4:00pm SATURDAY: 8:00am – 4:00pm SUNDAY: 8:00am – 3:00pm

MONDAY – FRIDAY: Inspections will only be done IF there are inspectors available. You may still get an inspection done, BUT you may have to wait a day or so. This is due to most inspectors running their own vehicles. Get your vehicle inspected early, if you are not in the line by 12;00 Sunday, you may have wait.

ONLY OFFICIALS AND THE CREW OF VEHICLES BEING INSECTED ARE PERMITTED IN THE INSPECTION AREA – NO SPECTATORS.
