



Lake Gairdner Induction SPEED WEEK 2021

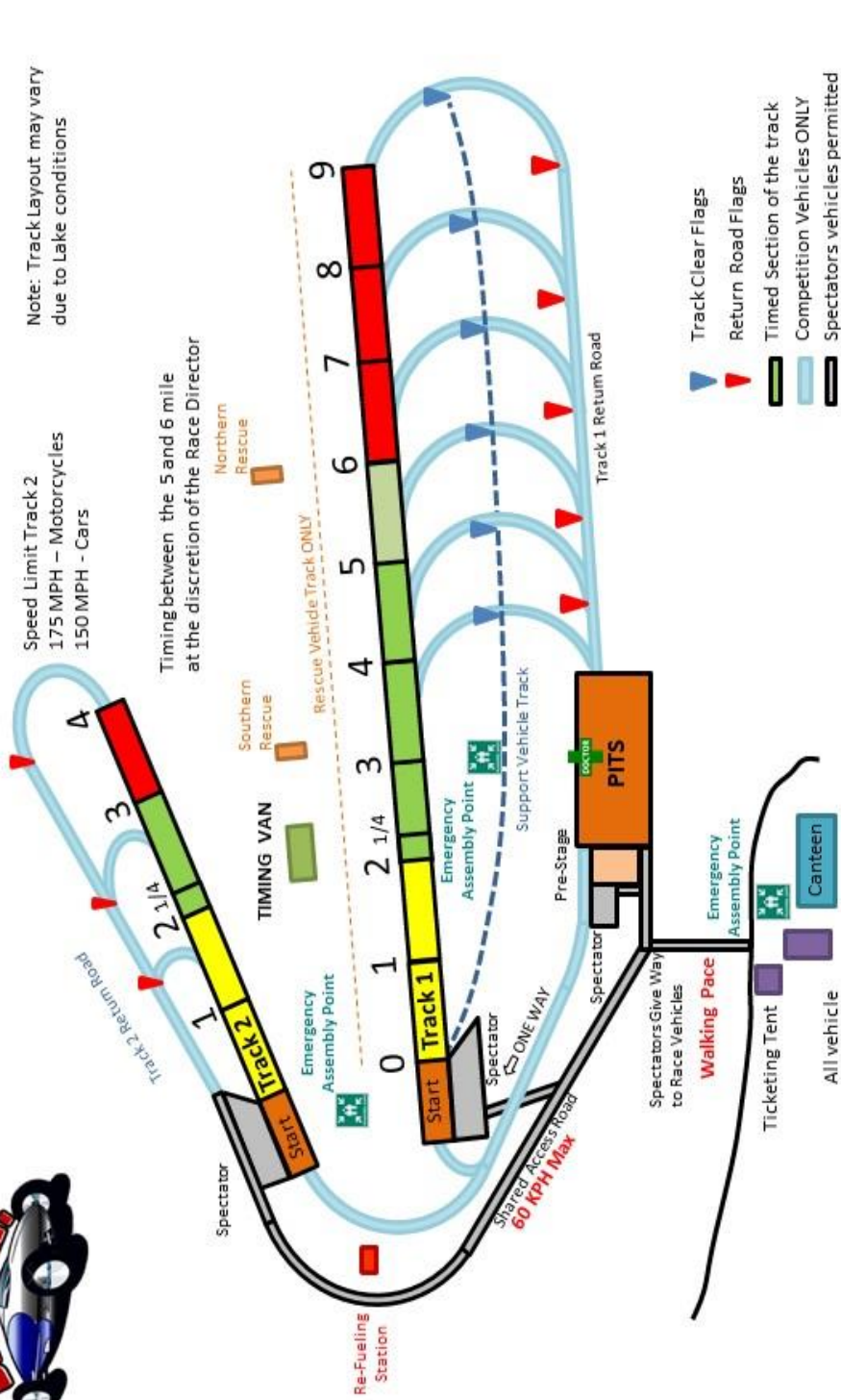
1. Dust off going on lake and salt off coming off the lake
2. Drive at walking pace on mats
3. 60kph speed limit on lake
4. Follow the witches hats and/or instruction of a DLRA official when travelling on the lake or for any information
5. Walking pace or 25kph max in pits- be aware that race vehicles have limited field of view and always have right of way
6. No access for spectators past the pits or past the start line
7. All vehicles including motorcycles must have a tarp placed under them at all times when parked
8. Helmets must be worn on all motorcycles and motorised bicycles
9. No riding in the back of utes or table tops. SA road rules apply
10. No cigarette butts on the lake. No rubbish bins are provided so ALL rubbish must be taken back off the lake.
11. Clear water is the only thing that can be dropped on the lake
12. There is a doctor available in the pits half way down on the left hand side.
13. DLRA admin/merchandise is available half way up the pits on the left hand side
14. Use channel 10 on UHF for communications and information.
15. Common sense applies- stay hydrated, use sunscreen and a hat, keep an eye on your mates and if you need attention please see the doctor or ask an official in DLRA uniform for help
16. Emergency Assembly Points are signposted in the pits, at lake entry, the Saltbush Camp and the DLRA Woolshed Camp
17. Lake Entry Wristbands MUST be worn at all times and must be shown to DLRA officials/volunteers before proceeding onto the lake otherwise another lake entry fee will be requested and charged
